Mead is classified as Honey Wine. As with any alcohol, there has to be a sugar that is used to create the alcohol. In mead, that sugar is honey. Similar to wine, mead can be dry or it can be sweet. It can have floral or fruity notes. It is considered one of the oldest fermented drinks, but has been experiencing a resurgence in recent years. Honey & Hops Brew Works will focus on creating
